Students will be empowered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sincerely interested in helping others beyond personal gain - concerned about the future - take ownership and responsibility <p>D2. Students will show empathy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - respect for diversity - connect to self and others - able to step into someone else's shoes - not seeing others as "less than" <p>D3. Students will be persistent/show grit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - use failure as opportunity for revision and next steps - don't take no for an answer - firmness of spirit or belief - display courage when met with challenge or adversity
